Hebrews 11:23; Exodus 1-2:10

<u>Big Idea</u>: Freedom from the fears of life is found through fearing the Lord

"By faith, Moses, when he was born, was hidden for three months by his parents, because they saw the child was beautiful, and they were not afraid of the king's edict." - Hebrews 11:23

"Know for certain that your offspring will be sojourners in a land that is not theirs and will be servants there, and they will be afflicted for four hundred years. But I will bring judgment on the nation that they serve, and afterwards they shall come out with great possessions." - Genesis 15:13-14

When Fear Draws Near (Hebrews 11:23; Exodus 1-2:10):

- 1) Behold God as bigger (Exodus 1:15-21)
 - a) Fear of the Lord: Trusting God wholeheartedly and doing what God says faithfully no matter the circumstance or consequence
 - b) "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is insight. For by me your days will be multiplied, and years will be added to your life." – Proverbs 9:10-11
 - c) Fear Busting Realities:
 - 1) My God Redeems
 - 2) My God Reigns
 - 3) My God Provides
 - 4) My God Protects
 - 5) My God Delivers
- 2) Believe God's Word to be greater (Hebrews 11:23; Exodus 1:22-2:10)
 - a) "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." John 14:15
 - b) "In the fear of the Lord one has strong confidence, and His children will have a refuge. The fear of the Lord is a foundation of life, that one may turn away from the snares of death." – Proverbs 14:26-27
