John 6:1-21

Big Idea: Faith is trusting our Savior and not ourselves in every season and situation

2 lessons from the school of faith (John 6:1-21):

Lesson 1: When the situation is overwhelming depend on Jesus’ provision
(v. 1-15)

A. When a situation overwhelms me, am I?

1. Ignoring and dismissing it (Mark 6:35-36)

a. “And when it grew late, his disciples came to him and said,
'This is a desolate place, and the hour is now late. Send
them away to go into the surrounding countryside and
villages and buy themselves something to eat.’”

- Mark 6:35-36

b . Applying human reasoning to it (v. 7)

c. Doubting Jesus in it (v. 8-9)

d. Surrendering it (v. 8-9)

Lesson 2: When the storm is raging focus on Jesus’ presence (v. 14-21)

A. “I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the
world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the
world.” - John 16:33
