

Turning Point 1 Samuel 26 & 28

Big Idea: In times of trouble, turning to God always provides me deliverance through God.

In My Trouble:

1) <u>Turning To God In Surrender Leads To Deliverance (26:1-25)</u> Biblical Principles For My Perseverance:

- 1) Don't Walk Alone (v. 6)
- 2) Be Led By The Holy Spirit Not By Circumstances (v. 8-9)
- 3) Follow God's Word Over Man's Word (v. 8-11)
- 4) Cling To God's Character For Confidence In The Crisis (v. 10, 21-25)

"I lift up my eyes to the hills. From where does my help come? My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth. He will not let your foot be moved; He who keeps you will not slumber." – Psalm 121 1:1-3

5) Surrender Is The Heart Posture That Unleashes God's Power (v. 9-10,

23-24)

"But He (The Lord) said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of JC may rest upon me. For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong." – 2 Corinthians 12:9-10
